



- ① Kinsley Avenue is converted to a one-lane one-way street for cars headed eastbound toward Downtown; a new shared use path is created along the River's edge.

Eagle Street is narrowed, but will still be bidirectional for cars; parallel on-street parking will be added to both sides of Eagle Street; the Eagle-Kinsley intersection will be redesigned to make it safer.

- ② Left turns from Dean Street onto Promenade Street will be prohibited to reduce congestion on the bridge and add time to the pedestrian signal to make it safer for people walking.
- ③ The Bath Street bridge is converted to one-way northbound travel only.
- ④ Promenade Street is narrowed to one lane, and continues in the westbound direction from Park Street. A new shared use path is created along the river.
