- Funds used for operating deficits due to COVID-19 should be considered temporary, therefore consideration should be made for change in future budgets.
- State and local jurisdiction should work together to maximize efficiency of fund usage
- Beneficiary cooperation (for example, between schools and economic development authorities) is highly encouraged
